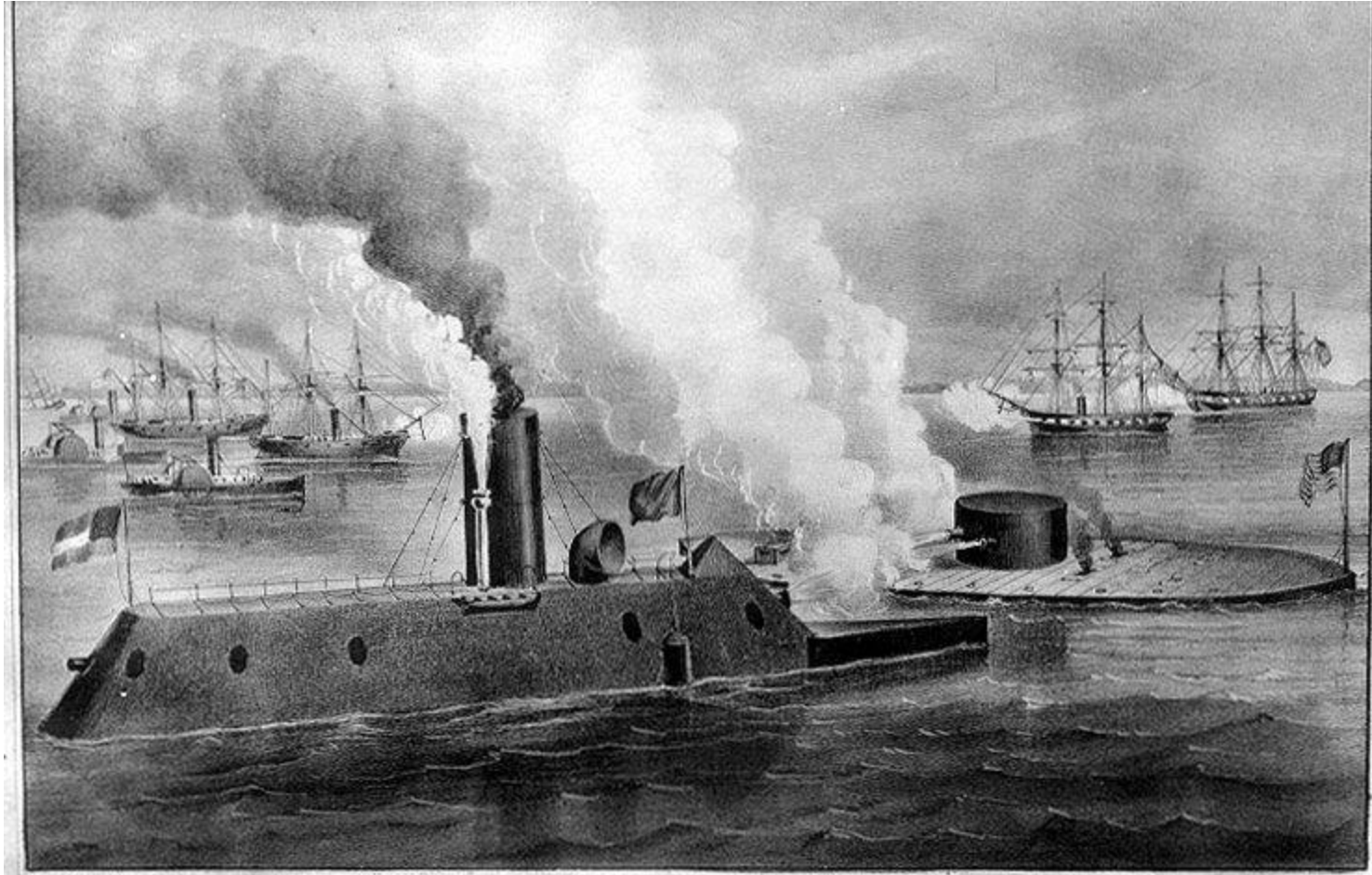

THE FIRST BATTLE BETWEEN IRON CLAD SHIPS OF WAR.

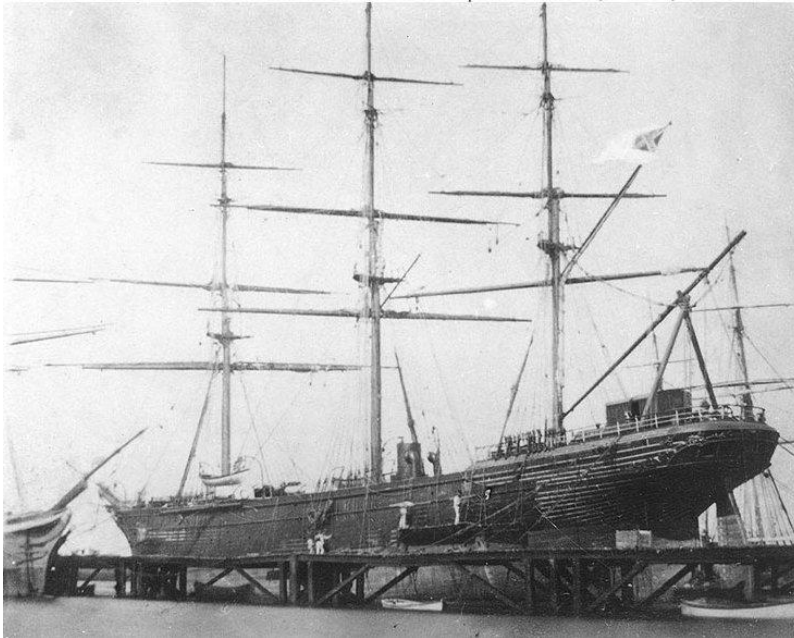

Remit for SHIS-R

- To create a research portal for EPRs already held by NHS Scotland (SHIS-R)
- To develop and evaluate innovative technical processes that allow linkage between large federated third party research datasets and SHIS-R
- To develop and evaluate systems that work across institutional boundaries with adequate data manipulation and statistical functionality that provide rapid, secure access to data
